

Zymbiot Games Releases "Phantom Trigger"

*Downloadable Version of Unique War Thriller
Available March 1, 2004*

February 15, 2004 - You're a special ops agent whose company has abandoned you in enemy territory. All you have to protect you is an automatic rifle, a handgun and some explosives. That might get you through the night. In order to get home you're going to need to make friends with some unsavory people, do some regrettable bartering and check your morals at the door. And if you do get home, you're going to need to pick a few bones with some former comrades.

Phantom Trigger, the first offering from New York City-based Zymbiot Games, becomes available for download from the company's website (www.zymbiot.com) on March 1. "*Trigger*" will be available for \$45.00, but those who download in the first 48 hours receive a \$10 discount.

Says Steve Kasslowitz, tri-founder of Zymbiot, "*Phantom Trigger* is not you're typical shoot-'em up, blow-'em up war game. You need to use your wits, intuition and cunning to win this game. There're tactics involved, sure, but you also need to be a good schmoozer, thief, and master of disguise."

"There are really two halves to this game," adds Michael Morrison, tri-founder. "There's the battlefront mission which takes place in a foreign land, and the revenge mission which takes place if and when you get back to the states. We're confident gamers will be get a lot of mileage out of *Phantom Trigger*."

In *Phantom Trigger*, gamers have the added function of naming and designing their own soldiers as well as giving them their own backstory. "Players really help us to continue to create the game by building the personalities of their soldiers," says Zymbiot tri-founder Justin Chen. "If you want your soldier to be a West Point grad who's served 10 tours in Iraq, you can build that profile."
